## **AT6AQ Battery Replacement Procedure**

The following information is provided to assist in the replacement of the AT6 batteries.

Please view the associated <u>video</u> which provides a visual representation of the procedure described below.

## Tools needed:

- Driver with a TORX # 8 adapter
- Flat Head screwdriver
- Small wood or plastic piece to hold board/SIM assembly during battery replacement

- 1. Remove the 2 TORX 8 screws on the housing using a screwdriver with a TORX #8 head.
- 2. Set aside the 2 screws and remove the housing cover.




3. Using a shim, as in the video, carefully disconnect the old battery connection and discard the battery.



## Airgain\*)))

- 4. Continue to hold the shim in place, reconnect a new battery and place it in the housing.
  - NOTE: The battery connector SNAPS in, it does NOT slide into the connector. Be careful that the pins do not bend, and the tabs do not break when working to reconnect a new battery. You should hear an audible SNAP when the connections are successful, and you should not be able to pull it out easily.
- 5. Replace cover and reinsert the TORX screws to secure the housing.
- 6. If you have not yet done so, record the unique serial number of the tracker you just replaced the battery in.
- 7. Open the N-Link Application and search for the S/N of the tracker you just replaced the battery in. Confirm that the tracker has successfully check into via the application.
